If you want to cite a book chapter in APA format, you need to include the chapter author's name either in the introductory phrase before the quote or in the parenthetical citation after it, along with the publication date and page number. For the Reference page, make sure you include the author, chapter title, editor, book title, page range, and publication information.

While APA requires italics for the title of a book, the title of a chapter in a book goes in regular type. Provide the information for the book's editor and the book after the chapter title: Author's last name, first Initial(s).

In APA, MLA and Chicago Style, when the book's chapters are written by different authors, you should cite the specific chapter you are referring to. Single-author books should be cited as a whole, even if you only quote or paraphrase from one chapter.
