You can form very simple sentences with just two words (who said Chinese was difficult?), for example: 我在忙(wǒ máng): I'm busy. 我在忙(wǒ) means "I" or in some cases "me". And 我在忙(máng) means "busy".

Chinese Grammar #6 - Basic Negative Form of Verbs In the Chinese language there are basically two adverbs used for negation - "bu" (不) and "méiyǒu" (没有). Both are placed before the verb in a sentence. Note that "shi" cannot be negated with "mei/you", and "you" cannot be negated with "bu".
