It is sponsored by the Harvard Semitic Museum and the Oriental Institute, University of Chicago, and funded by a generous grant from the Smithsonian Institution.

The Punic Excavations at Carthage (Tunisia) were undertaken by the American Schools of Oriental Research, Harvard University, and the University of Chicago, from 1975 through 1978. The excavations were under the archaeological supervision of Lawrence Stager, then of the Oriental Institute, University of Chicago.

The archaeological site was first surveyed in 1830, by Danish consul Christian Tuxen Falbe. Excavations were performed in the second half of the 19th century by Charles Ernest Beulé and by Alfred Louis Delattre. The Carthage National Museum was founded in 1875 by Cardinal Charles Lavigerie.

The museum is the product of excavations conducted by European archaeologists, in particular those made by Alfred Louis Delattre. The Annex was used at first to house the items found in searches in the necropolis of Carthage and excavations of the St. Louis hill but also Douimès, the hill of Juno, the Sainte-Monique Hill and also the Carthaginian Christian basilicas .
