Your basic task is to analyze the issue presented, considering more than one perspective, and to develop and support your position on the issue. There is no "correct" answer.

Perspectives: The GRE issue essay is, at the heart of it, a matter of perspective, and what you really think about the question at hand. There's no real, unequivocal 'right' or 'wrong' answer, because really it is the two sides of the same coin, with both sides being amenable to argument and support.
