Organized November 16, 1820, (effective January 1, 1821) from Ste. Genevieve County and named for Oliver H. Perry, naval hero of the War of 1812. Pettis County Organized January 26, 1833, from Cooper and Saline counties and named for Spencer Pettis, Missouri congressman.
