OFFICIAL ICD-9-CM GUIDELINES FOR CODING AND REPORTING
ICD-9-CM Official 4. Newborns, Coding Guidelines 2. A person with a resolving disease or injury, or a chronic, long-term condition requiring continuous care, encounters the health care system for specific aftercare of that disease or injury (e.g., dialysis for renal disease; chemotherapy for malignancy; cast change).

There are numerous guidelines that are useful when determining both the correct ICD-9 code as well as the correct current procedural terminology (CPT) code.
