Roman coinage was made of gold, silver, and bronze. As the value of the coin was initially linked to the value of the base metal, coinage was minted to specific weights. However, third parties would shave or clip small pieces from the edges of the coins. These metal shavings could then be collected and sold for their intrinsic worth.
